


| Prior within 2 years           | Fine                 | Costs    | Points | Suspension                                   |
|--------------------------------|----------------------|----------|--------|--|
| 0 (1 <sup>st</sup> offense)    | \$55.00 **           | \$125.00 | 2 **   | N/A  |
| 1 (2 <sup>nd</sup> offense)    | \$110.00             | \$125.00 | 3      | N/A  |
| 2+ (3 <sup>rd</sup> + offense) | Mandatory Appearance |          | 4      | Court may impose a 90-day License suspension |


\*Fine is doubled in a construction zone
